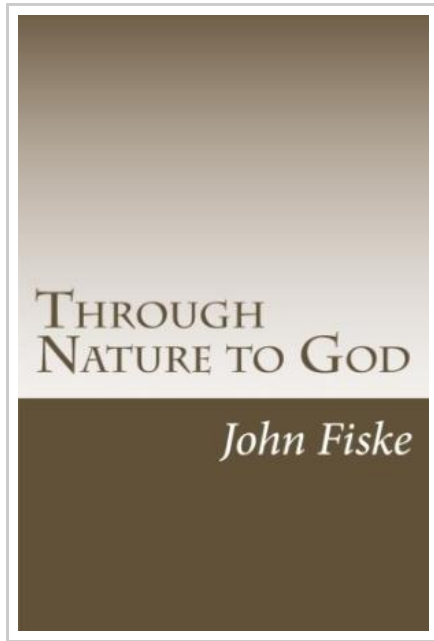




Through Nature to God (Paperback)
