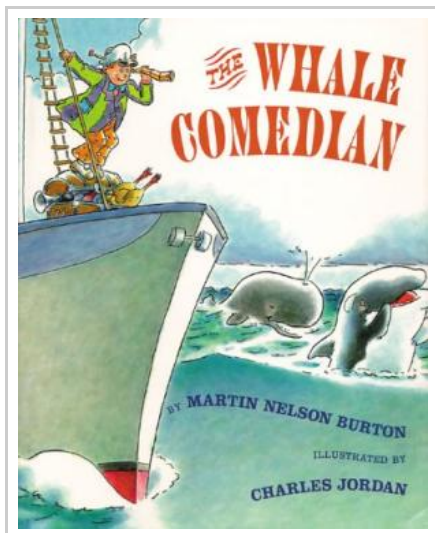




Whale Comedian (Hardback)
