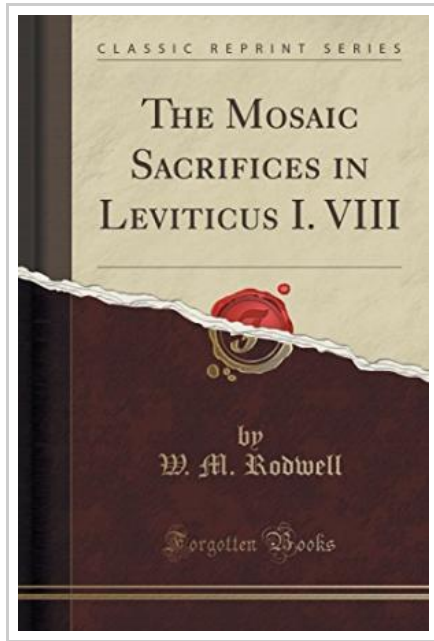

VIII All the Books of the Pentateuch are named by the Jews in accordance with their initial words. Thus, Genesis is called Bereschith, since it begins with that word; Exodus, Veelleh Shemoth; Numbers, Vayedabber; Deuteronomy, Elleh Haddebarim. The present book is called Vayikra. It is also called Torah Cohenim, i.e., The Law of the Priests, and so it is designated in the Arabic and Syriac Versions. In the Septuagint it is called Leuiticon and in our version Leviticus, since it treats of the sacrifices, the priesthood of Aaron, and various other rites and ceremonies, the due performance of which belonged strictly to the tribe of Levi, as being especially dedicated to the service of the sanctuary. The author of this Book was Moses: a fact which is not only admitted by the Jews, but which is confirmed by the authority of the New Testament in several places, e.g., compare S. Matthew viii. 4 with Lev. xiv. 4, 10: S. John viii. 5 with Lev. xx. 10, Deut. xxii. 22,...



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
