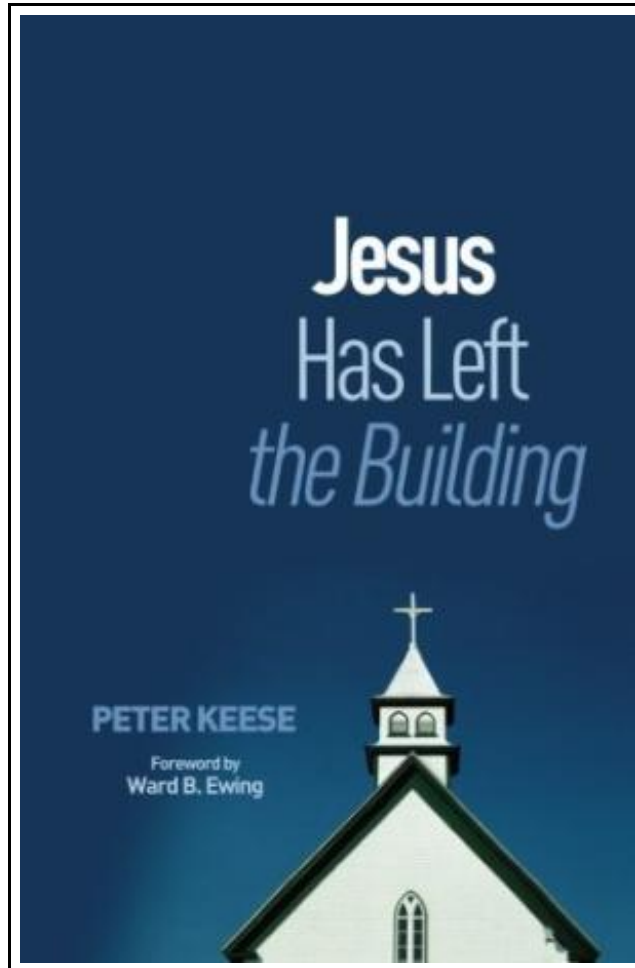


Jesus Has Left the Building (Paperback)
