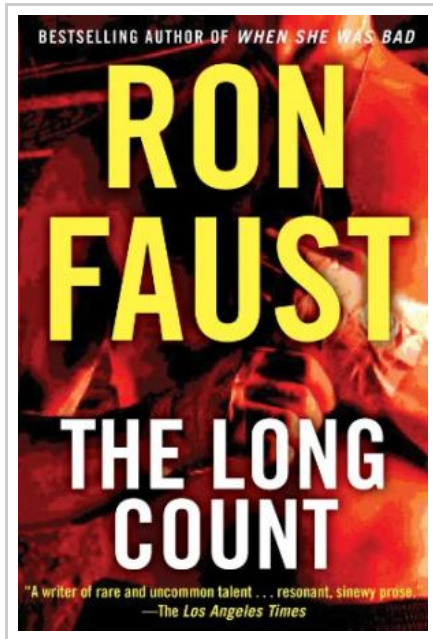




The Long Count
