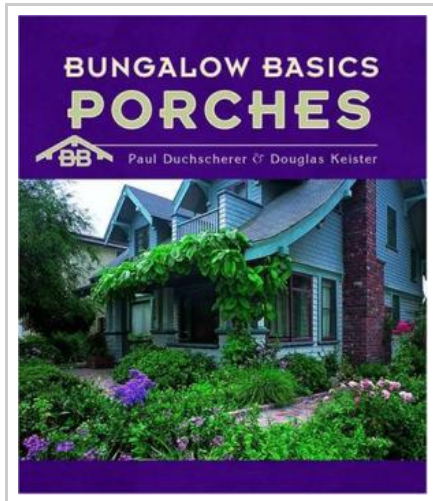




Bungalow Basics Porches (Hardback)
