Practically all of the important material in the earlier bulletins is reproduced and, in addition, there are added abstracts from, or digests of, the several very important studies made during the past year. Budgetary studies have two distinct phases. The first is the determination of the standards and quantities of things necessary to maintain a family at a certain level of living. The second is to ascertain the cost of the items arrived at as necessary for the purpose mentioned. The determination of the quantity budget is the more important and also the more difficult. The pricing of the quantity budget is a mere mechanical matter, involving nothing more than careful field work. The ultimate interest, however, lies in the cost of the budget. For the...
