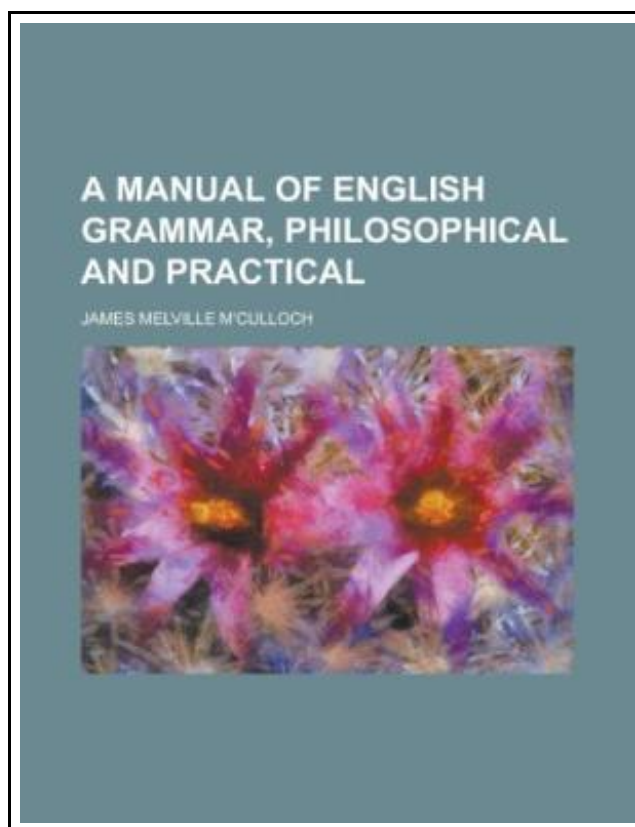

Thus, the termination ia is changed into y; as, from prosodici, prosody; from apologia, apology. Ikos is changed into ic or ical; as, from mechanikos, mechanic or mechanical. Ismos is changed into ism; as, from aphorismos. aphorism. Ogos is changed into ogue; as, from epilogus, epilogue. The number, however, of Latin and Greek words which have been adopted into English as separate words is comparatively small. INSEPARABLE BOOTS. The great proportion of the Latin and Greek roots of the English language is found only in composition. The changes which roots that are found only in composition undergo, cannot easily be reduced to general rules; but an inspection of the following lists will sufficiently illustrate their nature: --LATIN ROOTS FOUND ONLY IN COMPOSITION.
