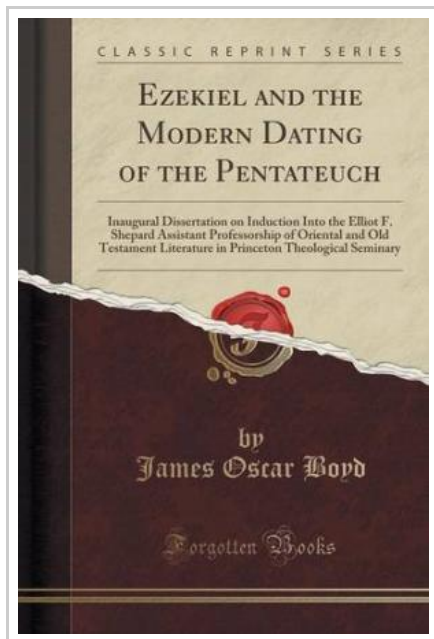

The book of Ezekiel, with one exception the largest of the prophets, is undisputed as to either its genuineness or its integrity. Here is a great mass of literature, filling over 80 pages of our Hebrew Bibles, about which there is no critical problem beyond that afforded by the correction of its text. For the purposes of the higher criticism the whole book is a datum. The contrast between this condition of affairs in the case of Ezekiel, and the state of confusion and division in the case of almost every other book of the Old Testament, is sufficient in itself to point to Ezekiel as worthy of a special place in this difficult field. 2.
